ZL1AOX suggested the Space Museum at Te Awamutu or possibly at one of the Universities such as Auckland or Massey. It was noted that several Degrees had been earned from research by Massey Students.

Dave Wilkin ZL1MR suggested Te Papa.

Ross Biggar ZL1WN suggested that the funds in the bank account could be used for a scholarship. Another suitable place for the funds would be the NZART Radio Science Education Trust.
